MFCC: Service by the Numbers

977 Individuals experienced food insecurity requiring food from the MFCC Emergency Food Shelf, 321 were under the age of 18 and 119 were senior citizens.

95 School Age Children received a new backpack filled with back-to-school supplies through the MFCC School Supply Drive.

82 Individuals received a coat from our Coat Drive to keep them warm during Vermont's cold winter. This year we partner with the Cornerstone Community Church.

197 Families were able to have enough food to feed their family and celebrate Thanksgiving through the MFCC Thanksgiving Food Drive.

270 Children from 117 families were able to receive gifts for the holiday through the MFCC Adopt-A-Family program.

18 Families received diapers through our diaper bank

93 Welcome Baby Bags handed out. These bags are filled with information for new parents and some gifts for the new child.

12 Families received 1-on-1 support through our Home Visiting Program

82 Playgroups were offered. With a total of 105 children (ages 0-5) and 82 caregivers came.

41 Children ages 6 weeks - 5 years atteneded our full day/full year Early Childcare Program (ECP).


108 Children in grades K-6th attended our Milton AfterSchool Program (MASK).


